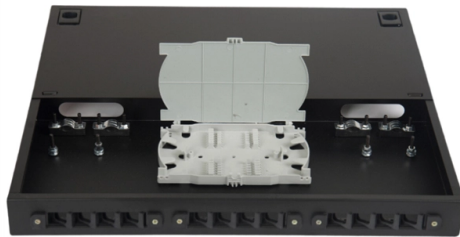


## Fiber optic router fan is loud



### Overview

If the problem is a loud fan: updating the firmware could solve overheating problems that lead to constant loud fan noise. If that doesn't quiet your router, you might need to add a cooling element (attach a cheap heatsink to it with some thermal paste), or buy a new router. Home routers are usually quiet, fanless devices, but solid state electronics do sometimes emit noise due to electronic resonance of certain frequencies, overheating parts, firmware, poor hardware quality and poor device placement.
