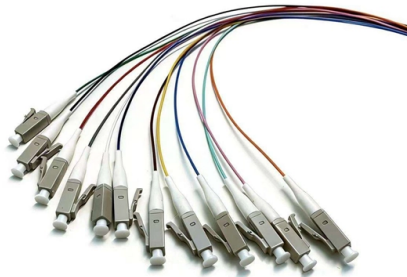


Ghana Power Fiber Cable Laying Project
